

The Spiritual Leadership Team: Pastor Bray, Associate Pastor Frazer, Deacons Steve Curless, David Hunt, and Norman Muller, met December 12, 2020 to discuss our ongoing response to the pandemic.

- One: We can only respond to the best of our ability. Every effort will be made to maintain sanitary conditions at the church building for those who attend in the event.
- Two: So far as we know here has not been any member of the church, or a regular attender who has tested positive for the COVID-19 virus. We have had one person who became aware of a family member who tested positive. That person immediately notified the pastor and was able to be tested. They tested negative. That person will not be attending until quarantine is satisfied.
- Three: For the immediate future Sunday School will continue to meet with volunteer workers. Masks will be worn the full-time since the classrooms are too small for social distancing. Attendance should be decided by each family.
- Four: Everyone entering the building is requested to allow their temperature to be taken. Masks will be worn when moving around the building and may be removed when seated. Seating in the auditorium is set up for social distancing allowing families to sit together.
- Five: Masks are available for those who do not have one. Hand sanitizer is available and encouraged to be used, especially if physical contact with another person has occurred.
- Six: Anyone who is not comfortable with contact is encouraged to follow live streaming services online. www.sbchurch.org has a link to our Facebook page on the homepage. As long as we have volunteers available live streaming will be maintained.
